### The Moment in Advent

Led by: The Simmons Family

#### SCRIPTURE READING — Matthew 1:18–23 (NRSV) (please stand)

#### Reader:

"Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. Her husband Joseph, being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public

disgrace, planned to dismiss her quietly. But just when he had resolved to do this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, 'Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife, for the child conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins. 'All this took place to fulfill what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet:

'Look, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel,' which means, 'God is with us.'"

**Reader:** This is the Word of God for the people of God.

**People:** Thanks be to God.

#### FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT LITANY: HOPE

**Leader:** Church family, today we step into Advent—a season of watching, waiting, and expecting God to show up. And we begin with **HOPE**. Not wishful thinking. Not blind optimism. But the kind of hope that knows: **God keeps His word.** 

**People:** Our hope is in the God who comes close.

**Leader:** Matthew tells us that when Joseph felt uncertain and life didn't make sense, God didn't leave him guessing. God sent a word. God sent clarity. God sent **Presence**.

**People:** When we don't know what to do, God still knows how to find us.

**Leader:** This year at Bethel, we've declared that we are going **ALL IN**. And Advent reminds us why we can be ALL IN — because before we ever reached for God, **God came ALL IN for us.** 

**People:** Emmanuel—God with us—gives us hope to keep going.

**Leader:** Hope is not the absence of struggle. Hope is the assurance that God steps into our struggle with us. God shows up in the questions. God shows up in the confusion. God shows up in the waiting.

**People:** Hope is knowing we are never alone.

**Leader:** As we light the first candle, we declare that "The Gift of His Presence" is the anchor for our faith, the strength in our journey, and the promise for our future.

**People:** Lord, make Your presence real to us this season.

**Leader:** Let hope rise again—in our families, in our children, in our worship, in our community, and in every place where darkness has tried to settle.

**People:** Let hope shine through us as we live ALL IN for You.

**Leader:** Christ our Hope, Christ our Light, Christ our Emmanuel — we welcome You into this season and into our hearts.

All Together: God with us, fill us with hope today. Amen.


